



We will have Family Displaced and Hospitality Centers working in conjunction with family Veterans, women and children centers, This will center with Active Duty Military members if the spouse of a military member is kill in action and the wife of that love one is now gone we will have special programs in place for the women and the children to help them with temporary shelter, food and clothing if need to be job placement. We will have the right professionals including ministers to help the displaced family get stable. These Centers will be staff by people who are trained and license.

Our Women Crisis Centers will Assist women in crisis with temporary shelter, rehabilitation care, as well as Job placement and training at no cost to them. We will have Women’s re-treat centers as well the Center will function in at least three different capacities: Women will come for day retreats, three-day Weekend retreat and or Week-long retreats. The Retreat Center will be for women to get away, relax, learn new ways of adapting to lifestyle changes due to divorce, death of spouse or loved one, financial loss, etc. We will have classes in job skills, budgeting and becoming financially sustainable through learned skills.

As we partner with other organizations, farmers, ranchers, federal, state and local officials we will begin to implement our farm to table program, Veterans Homeless Shelters of Mid-America, food service groups, etc. which will support our Veterans, their families and others in need.

Under the Family Vision Network of Mid-America, we want to address the whole family in all areas of there life. Our Veterans Programs we will address policy issues impacting our Veterans and family members. Providing hope to Veterans and their family, helping with PTSD, abuse and other medical issues, we want to provide a process for healing in all areas of that person’s life. Our care centers will provide good quality counseling, medical, and spiritual help.

## **WOMEN'S VISION NETWORK OF MID-AMERICA**

is a program to assist women in crisis with temporary shelter, educational training, rehabilitation and counseling as well as assistance for job skills/ placement with several of our work programs. Other areas of help include emotional healing, drug and alcohol rehabilitation as well as spiritual retreat centers for women.

## **MILITARY-VETERANS NETWORK OF MID-AMERICA**

is an initiative for Veterans to include medical support for PTSD, drugs and alcohol abuse which includes a 3-step program.

## **VETERANS HOMELESS SHELTERS OF MID-AMERICA**

is a 3-step program with a soup kitchen and work program on site with medical professionals and counselors. We will also have programs called Veterans Drop Zone, Veterans Landing Zone, trade schools and apprenticeship programs along with Veterans Village. All these programs and projects are free to Veterans and their family. Medical programs will also be free.
